Just in time for the holidays, Mural Routes has created 2017 calendars featuring our murals from across Toronto!

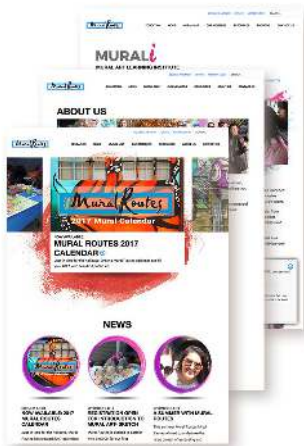
